- The practice schedule will be set by the coach. Parents should be prepared to have their child picked up promptly at the end of practice.
- Sailors are required to inform the coach of any absences from practices or meets.
- US Coast Guard approved Life Jackets shall be worn at all times in a boat. Life Jackets are not provided by the program you must supply your own.
- All students will be required to take a short swim test prior to sailing a boat. Swimming proficiency is expected.
- Wearing of Dry Suits is required. No Sailor will be allowed on the water without a fully functioning Dry Suit.
- Students must obey all EGYC and GBSA rules and regulations. They have been
 extremely generous in allowing us to participate here. Always be mindful of boat traffic in
 the channel.
- Observe the boundaries on shore and on water as established by the coach.
- Students are expected to respect and obey the directions of the coach at all times. In addition, the EGYC Manager, staff and members shall also be respected and obeyed.
- Students shall respect the environment, both on land and in water. Please be sure to pick up any trash you generate (and other trash when applicable). Personal belongings shall be neatly stored in designated areas.
- Students shall show respect for the property. Students shall show respect for their peers, competitors, others, and themselves.
- Taunting, bullying, and/or the use of obscene language are strictly forbidden.

I have read and understand this Code of Conduct and have explained them to my child. Failure to obey these rules may result in loss of privileges as deemed fit by the coach depending on the severity of the infraction.
